- 1. Submit this completed and signed application by email or postmarked no later than 11:59 PM on June 30, 2021 to the President of the Imperial Court of New York.
- 2. Submit a minimum of two (2) signed letters of recommendation from individuals not associated with the Imperial Court System individuals with the completed application.
- 3. Be an Imperial Court member in good standing.
 - a. Per the Imperial Court of New York Bylaws, a member in good standing is one that has paid their annual membership dues (Section 2.02.2) and attended (6) General Membership Meetings and/or Board of Directors Meetings in the current fiscal year (Section 2.02.3).
- 4. Have been an active member in good standing for a minimum of three (3) complete years of service at the time of application.
- 5. Have chaired or co-chaired an ICNY-related event and a Night of a Thousand Gowns (NOATG) committee.
- 6. Have excellent Communication Skills.
- 7. Actively participated in at least six (6) in-town Court related events.
- 8. Have performed in or hosted an ICNY Court related event.
- 9. Not been convicted of a felony within the last seven (7) years.
